Content of CLAT



English: The English section on the CLAT will test a candidate's ability to competently comprehend complex reading material. It will also test a students' grasp of the English language in terms of complex grammar, logic and vocabulary in context.



Quant: This section tests a candidate's ability to use numbers and apply logic to arrive at a solution. Most questions on the CLAT are derived from what you should have learnt at the 8th to 10th standard in school.



Legal Reasoning: This section is the hallmark of the CLAT and will again test logic, but at a high level. The questions in this section are like advanced reading comprehension passages and will test your flair for analysing situations based on restrictions.




Logic/Analytics: The Reasoning section of the CLAT consists of 40 problems collectively designed to measure your ability to read critically, evaluate arguments, and recognize formal written English, identify series, formulate strategies.



GK (Current Affairs and Legal GK): This section focuses on a candidates awareness of his surroundings. Basically the current affairs section can be answered by anyone who reads the newspapers regularly.

Course Structure
